-The outdoor portion is done **here** on our property in the back (private) nature background. You may choose all indoor if you don't want any outdoor.

-For the \$99 Head Shot Photo Session you will see all the proofs. You will pick 25 images that are your favorite. I professionally touch up and edit your top 25 photos and deliver to you the 25 digital images.

-As many wardrobe changes as you like. Private Bathroom as well as a guest room to use to lay things out. Our studio is pet free and child free.

-The Photos will be sent to you by a Link on our website. A private online gallery for you to download/share/print. I will email you a password for your online private photo gallery. You will see the proofs (approximately 30-40 images) then choose your favorite 15 images that you want edited. *please allow one week for delivery of photos to the gallery.

-You will download your photos from our website. The link is sent to your email in about a week. (Usually less...but we ask for one week)

Head Shots-3 Reasons you should get an updated Head Shot!

1. Provide an accurate portrait of yourself
